

HEALTHeNL Application Changes

What's Changing and What's Staying the Same — Physician Reference

Advance Healthcare Directive Registry (AHCD)

The AHCD in HEALTHeNL is a locator registry only — it records where a patient's Advance Healthcare Directive is stored, not the directive itself. HEALTHeNL does not store actual AHCD documents. CorCare has its own AHCD functionality and the relationship between the two systems post go-live is being resolved. The location list will need updating to reflect CorCare as a valid storage location.

Registry Function	HEALTHeNL AHCD continues to show where a directive is stored — function unchanged in the near term Physicians can still access AHCD location information via HEALTHeNL Important: HEALTHeNL does not store the actual AHCD document — it is a list of storage locations only	New location entries will need to be added — CorCare must be added as a valid storage location
CorCare Functionality	Existing AHCD location records in HEALTHeNL are not being deleted	CorCare has its own Advanced Care Directive module — a parallel system will exist post go-live Physicians may need to check both HEALTHeNL and CorCare for AHCD information — this coexistence model is being resolved
EpicCare Link Access	HEALTHeNL access for community physicians remains available	It is not yet confirmed whether EpicCare Link will expose AHCD functionality to community and EMR physicians — further communication will follow
Legacy & History	Current AHCD records in HEALTHeNL remain accessible	The team is assessing whether existing Meditech AHCD records will move to CorCare
