## **USEFUL INFORMATION**

- A family room is located outside the Critical Care Unit
- A chapel is located outside the Critical Care Unit in the main foyer
- For your convenience, an intercom system is located on the wall outside the Critical Care Unit's main door. Please press the silver button on the intercom panel to request permission to visit your family member
- The cafeteria is located on the main floor.
- During the admission process your family member may be asked if they have an Advance Health Care Directive. We encourage you to ask the staff of the Critical Care Unit for a booklet about this and to ask any questions you might have.
- The Critical Care Unit has a cardiac rehabilitation program that your family member may be participating in. If you would like to take part in the education portion of the program, please feel free to speak to one of the critical care nurses.



The Critical Care Unit is a specialized care area where admitted patients are constantly observed by trained personnel. Families are permitted to visit in accordance with the visiting regulations listed below. Any exception to these regulations is at the discretion of the nurse in charge

#### VISITING

- Visiting is restricted to immediate family or significant others
- Not more than two visitors shall be permitted at one time
- Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the Critical Care Unit, except in exceptional circumstances. The decision to allow children to visit will be decided in consultation with the nurse manager or the nurse in charge. Special preparation of children may be necessary.

## **CELL PHONES**
