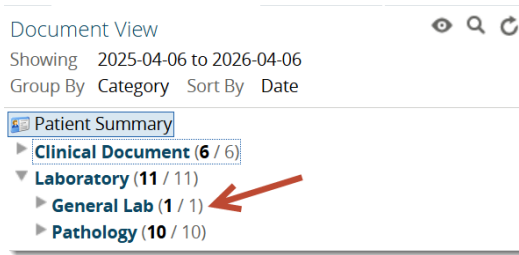
Transition to CorCare

The upcoming transition from Meditech to CorCare introduces a new folder structure and updated report locations in the clinical document view (CDV Tree). These changes are necessary to standardize how information is organized across our systems, improve navigation efficiency, and support the broader transition to CorCare. While the underlying clinical workflows you rely on remain the same, the way files and folders are arranged within the system will look different. These updates are being implemented to ensure a more consistent and sustainable digital environment for all users.

Key Changes:

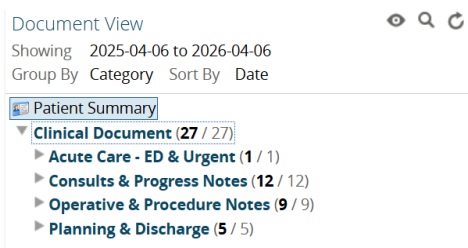
Laboratory

- Chemistry and Hematology reports are now combined into one General Lab folder



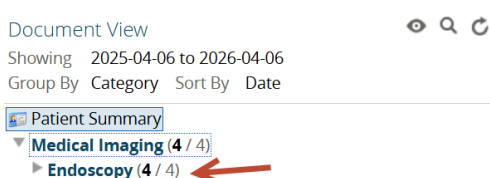
Clinical Documents

- Planning & Discharge



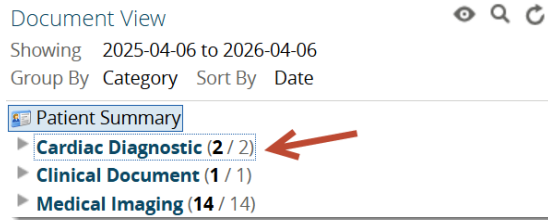
Endoscopy Reports

- Now in Cardiac Diagnostic

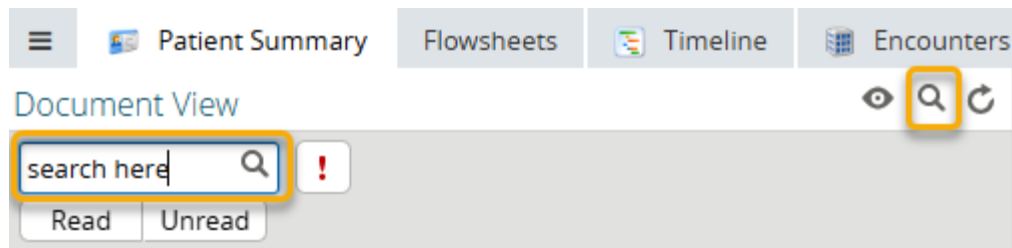


Historical Reports
